

- Butterflies are a kind of insect. They grow through <u>various</u> stages.

 Then they reach the end of their life cycles and die. The young usually look like small adults but without wings. Each kind has its own life cycle which could be completely different from other insects' life cycles.
- 2 Many butterflies start their life cycle as caterpillars. There are four stages in the life of butterflies: egg, larva, pupa, and adult. Eggs are laid on plants by the adult female butterfly. These plants will then become the food for the hatching caterpillars. Butterflies also need the sun and water to grow. When they have what they need, they start to grow. The next stage is the larva. This is also called a caterpillar if the insect is a butterfly or a moth. The job of the caterpillar is to eat and eat and eat. As the caterpillar grows it splits its skin and sheds it about 4 or 5 times. Caterpillars can grow 100 times their size during this stage.
- When the caterpillar is fully grown and stops eating, it becomes a pupa. The pupa of butterflies is also called a chrysalis. This stage can last from a few weeks, a month or even longer. The adult stage is what most people think of when they think of butterflies. They look very different from the larva. The caterpillar has a few tiny eyes, short legs and very short feelers. The adults have long legs, long feelers, and compound eyes. They can also fly by using their large and colorful wings. Most adult butterflies live only one or two weeks, but some species hibernate during the winter and may live several months.

- Lionel Andrés Messi, born on 24 June 1987, is an Argentine footballer who currently plays for Barcelona and the Argentine national team. He is one of the best football players of his generation and is frequently considered as the world's best contemporary player. In fact, I always compare his playing style and ability to Diego Maradona.
- Lionel Messi's talent was early detected by his father. When he <u>began</u> playing with the local team, his talent was quickly identified by Barcelona . At the age of 11, he was diagnosed with a *growth hormone deficiency*, which is a medical condition in which the body does not produce enough *growth hormone* and whose treatment needs a lot of money. He left his country in 2000 and moved with his family to Europe, as Barcelona offered treatment for his growth hormone deficiency. Making his entrance in the 2004–2005 season, he broke the *La Liga* record for the youngest footballer to play a league game, and also the youngest to score a league goal. Major honours soon followed as Barcelona won *La Liga* in Messi's entrance season and won double the league and Champions League in 2006. His breakthrough season was in 2006–2007; he became a first team regular, scoring a hat-trick in El Clásico and finishing with 14 goals in 26 league games. Perhaps his most successful season was the 2008–2009 season, in which Messi scored 38 goals to play an integral part in a treble-winning campaign.
- Messi was the top scorer of the 2005 FIFA World Youth Championship with six goals, including two in the final game. Shortly afterward, he became an well-known member of Argentina's senior international team. In 2006, he became the youngest Argentine to play in the FIFA World Cup and he won a runners-up medal at the Copa América tournament the following year.

- Do you know what the hump of a camel is used for? If you answered to store water, guess again. This rumor about camels storing water in their humps has been around for a long time, but it's not true. A camel's hump is a storage place for fatty tissue. Most animals, including humans, store fat throughout their bodies, **beneath** their skin. But camels store their fat in one place, their hump.
- Camels have amazing survival skills built into their bodies. Their humps contribute to the camel staying cooler because all the body fat is concentrated to one area instead of being spread throughout the body. Also, camels are great at handling changes in body temperature. They need to reach temperatures over 106 degrees Fahrenheit before they begin to sweat. And when they do sweat, it evaporates while on the camel's skin, instead of on its coat. This cools the camel much faster. Their coats also help them adapt to the heat. While the coat is thick, it reflects the sunlight and protects the camel from the heat that rises off the desert sand.
- There are two kinds of camels, those with one hump and those with two humps. Camels with one hump are called Dromedary or Arabian camels. They live in the dry deserts in West Asia. Camels with two humps are called Bactrian camels. They live in Central and East Asia.
- A camel can drink 26 gallons of water at a time. If that's not interesting enough, camels have three sets of eyelids. Two of these sets come complete with eyelashes, while the third set is skin. Camels can also close their nostrils. So, whether a camel has one hump or two, it is an amazing creature that is very well adapted to its environment.
