Art Ellison is the administrator of the New Hampshire State Bureau of Adult Education in USA, which helps fund many programs for grown-ups who need to improve their skills. He says most people in these classes never finished high school. Some of them weren't successful students, while others dropped out of school so that they could go to work and support their families.

Not being able to read well as a grown-up can make life very difficult and cause complications at work and at home. There is also an emotional toll.

Often, adults with difficulty reading try to hide their problem from others. For example, Mr. Ellison explains, it's not uncommon for someone applying for a job to ask if he or she can take home an

application. There, the applicant can ask a friend or even a daughter or son to help fill out the form. Others try to disguise their inability to read the options on a menu by pointing to a photograph of a dish instead, or by saying, "I'll have what that person's having."

Not being able to read at all is called illiteracy, and it can be dangerous. A person who can't read the instructions on a bottle of medication could end up in the hospital after taking too many pills, or after taking too few pills.

Some people graduated from high school but don't have good reading skills. That's partly because some schools have a policy of passing students onto the next grade, even if they haven't mastered all the material covered.
