

French fries are one of the most common food around the world . French fries are long, thin pieces of potato fried in oil or fat . Vegetables oil is the best fat to make amazing fries . 



In 490 b c Pheidippides ran from Marathon to Athens (about 26 miles, or 40 kilometers) to deliver news about the Greeks' success in a battle against the Persians. 
