also is usually placed before the main verb or after the verb *be*.

Too is usually placed at the end of the sentence.

For example:

*I've been to Spain. I've **also** been to Turkey.*

*I've been to Spain. I've been to Turkey **too**.*

or connects positive alternatives.

Nor connects **negative** alternatives when the first one is introduced by a negative such as *not, never, or neither*.

When we use ***nor***, the subject and object change places as in question form.

For example:

*Have you ever ridden a camel **or** tried sand skiing?*

*I've **never** ridden a camel, **nor** have I tried sand skiing.*

however, and ***on the other hand*** are used to express contrast to a previous statement.

Unlike ***but***, which goes in the middle of a sentence, they usually go **at the beginning of a sentence** and are followed by a comma.

For example:

*He has gone snow skiing, **but** he hasn't gone sand skiing.*

*He has gone snorkeling. **However**, he hasn't gone scuba diving.*

*He likes fishing. **On the other hand**, he rarely eats fish.*

of course and ***in fact*** are used to give emphasis.

They are usually followed by a comma.

For example:

*He likes skateboarding. **Of course**, he always wears a helmet.*


*He has traveled around the world. **In fact**, he has visited 63 countries.*

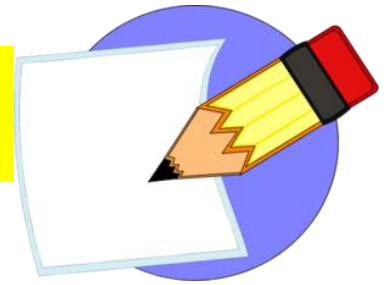

Extreme sports, also known as action sports or alternative sports, sporting events or pursuits characterized by high speeds and high risk. The sports most commonly placed in this group are skateboarding, snowboarding, freestyle skiing, in-line roller-skating, street lugeing, and BMX and mountain biking. Typically, extreme sports operate outside traditional mainstream sports and are celebrated for their adrenaline-pumping thrills. Racing and acrobatic competitions for motorcycles and snowmobiles are also often classified as "extreme," and the term can be stretched to include such daring pursuits as rock climbing and skydiving.

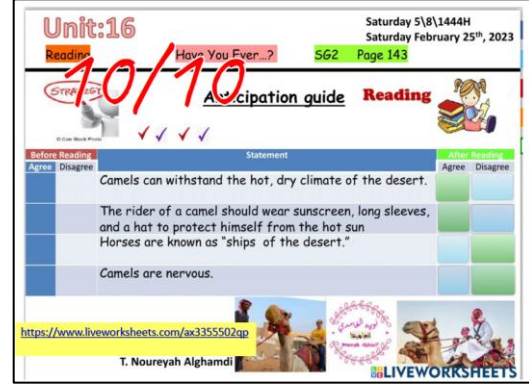
