an example, by giving directions to a place in the vicinity (area) of the school that
students will know

☺ The location of other cities or countries in relation to our
location.

For example:

Makkah is east of Jeddah.
Tabuk is north of Jeddah.



☺ to give directions to places you know.

For example: Can you tell me where the library is?
How can I get to the bus stop?
Excuse me. Where is the nearest supermarket?
