Real Talk

exercise freak = someone who exercises a lot

Anyway = a word to introduce a change in topic

You see = a phrase to introduce an explanation



Who says Anyway? (Omar)

So when do we say Anyway? (when we want to change the topic)

For example : *I have a test tomorrow, and it's going to be really hard.*

When dividing students into groups, group students of different ability levels together. That way, those who know more will be challenged to explain the material to those who are having difficulty, and they all will learn the material better.

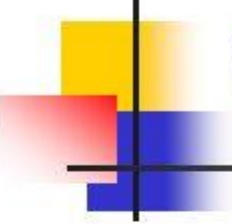


Additional Activity

Have students role-play a conversation similar to the conversation between Majid and Omar about two different pastimes, for example, playing a sport and playing video games.

What is Internet

- All computers on the Internet communicate with one another using the Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol suite, abbreviated to TCP/IP.
- Computers on the Internet use a client/server architecture.
- The remote server machine provides files and services to the user's local client machine.
- Software can be installed on a client computer to take advantage of the latest access technology.
